The total amount paid for Hartmann IV solution for each financial year since April 2017 and the individual bag cost charged for each of these tax years.

Response:

The Trust believes that providing the individual bag cost charged for each year is of commercial interest and may prejudice either the supplier or the Trust as quantities may then be calculated. The Trust is therefore applying Section 43 of the Act (Commercial Interests).

Applied Exemption

Section 43 (Commercial Interests):

- (3) The duty to confirm or deny does not arise if, or to the extent that, compliance with section 1(1) (a) would, or would be likely to, prejudice the interests mentioned in subsection (2)
