The guideline was revised to reflect application to all in-patient settings across the Trust, rather than solely the mental health settings. The following points were revised:

- Updated reference to link other Trust policies and good practice guidance (1.4.7 and 1.4.10).
- Change of scope to be inclusive of all Trust premises (2.3)
- Link to maintaining privacy and dignity (4.1)
- Reference to service users of 'all ages' (4.3) and all clinical settings (5.1)
- Reference to culture in addition to sexuality and gender (4.4)
- Updated organisational function to include physical health alongside mental health care (6.2)
- Update to risk factors to include 'cognitive impairment' (6.3.1)
- Has your organisation accepted vicarious liability for any cases of sexual assault or violence concerning any staff or patients in the past five years (2017 to date) (Please include any cases that may have led to an out of court settlement.)
