In CAMHS we refer to the generic SOP and use the patient posters so we didn't deviate in any way to ensure consistency. If a young person has assessed capacity to consent then there is no difference in the management of this process. If they do not have assessed capacity (regardless of age) this will be assessed and documented in the usual way, including parents/ carer in any process. Section 5.1 and 5.2 of the SOP discusses consent, implied consent and parent/carers consent.
