We only have the information recorded from March 2019 to current date

- WECHS and SEE CHS Bariatric profiling beds, pressure care (purchased) £18,575.68 + VAT

WECHS Bariatric profiling beds, mattresses and pumps (Rental only) =
£11,051.00
Manual and powered Wheelchairs = £9,053.00
Equipment service = £20,272.00

SEE CHS:

- Bariatric profiling beds, mattresses and pumps (rentals only) = £6,582 excl. VAT
- Manual and powered wheelchairs = £25,170

Mother & Baby

- £3,858.00 (to include ligature reduced design bariatric bed, mattress and appropriate bedding, armchair and dining chair.
