MSE Shared Care Record Overview

The MSE Shared Care Record from Oracle Health, is another way of accessing and viewing additional patient information in SystmOne. This supplements the Cerner HIE (Third Party Patient Record) and can be found directly beneath Third Party Patient Record in the SystmOne Clinical Tree.

The Shared Care Record is not fully integrated, and instead opens an internet URL link where you can view the patient information online. Shared Care Record is completely secure and cannot be accessed outside of the patient record in SystmOne.

You will be unable to access the Shared Care Record for more than one patient at a time. If you open Shared Care Record for an additional patient, the current patient you are in will close.

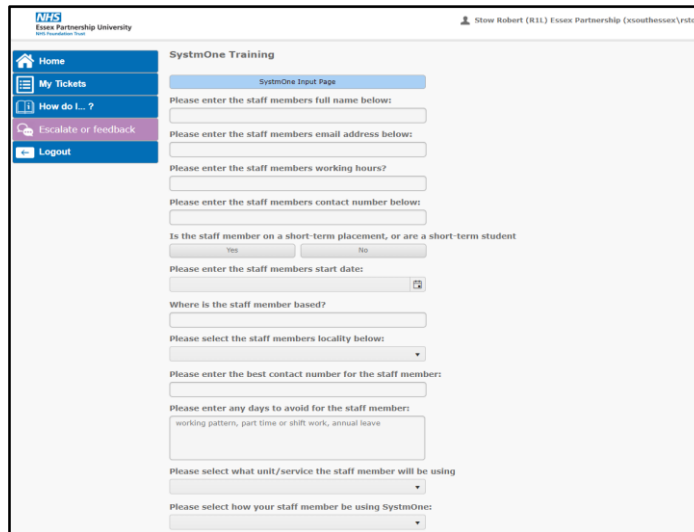
For security, there is a 'time-out' period of 5 minutes – this means if you have opened the Shared Care Record, but leave it idle and do not access any of the information, the Browser will log you out of the session, and you will need to re-open it from the patient record in SystmOne. You will be given a notification just prior to the record closing.

This User Guide will take you through the basics of accessing and navigating MSE Shared Care Record.

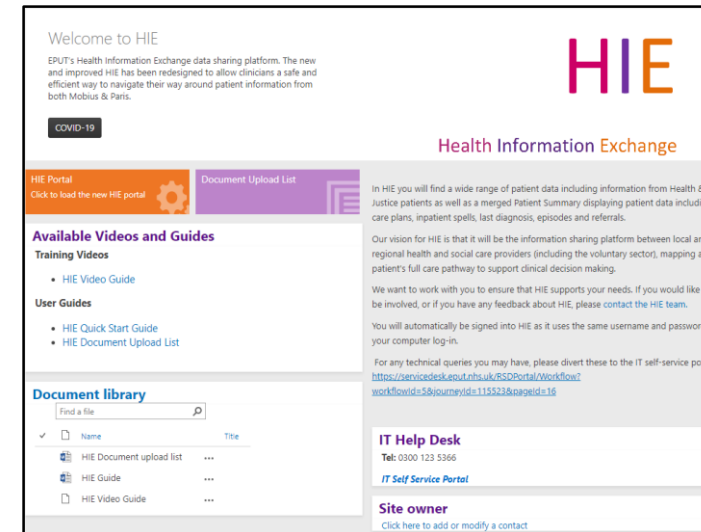

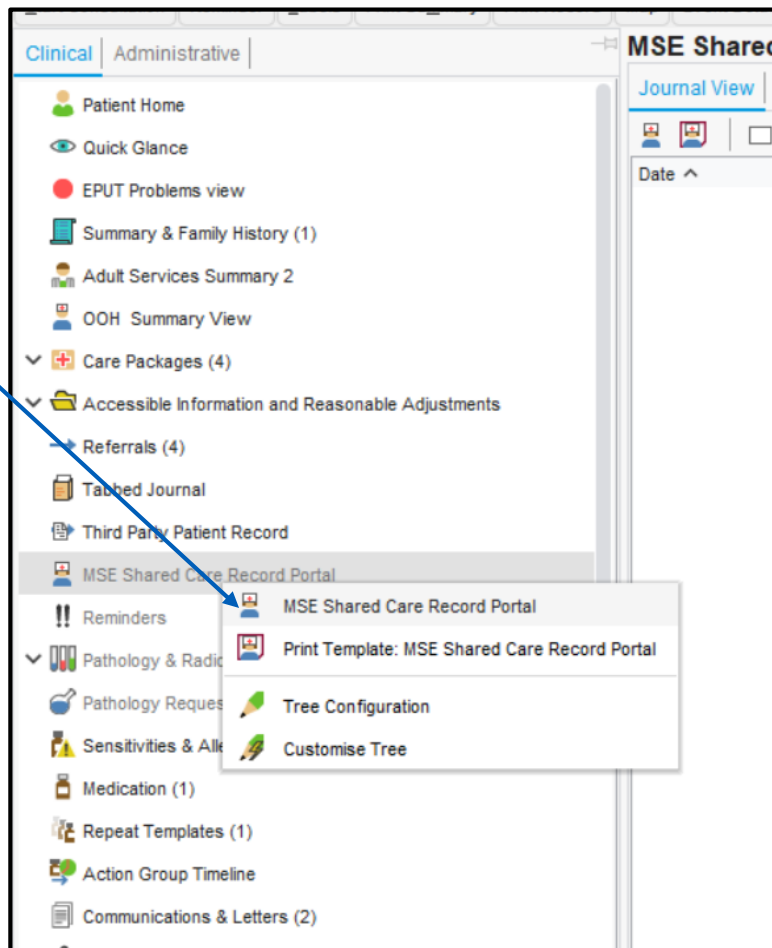

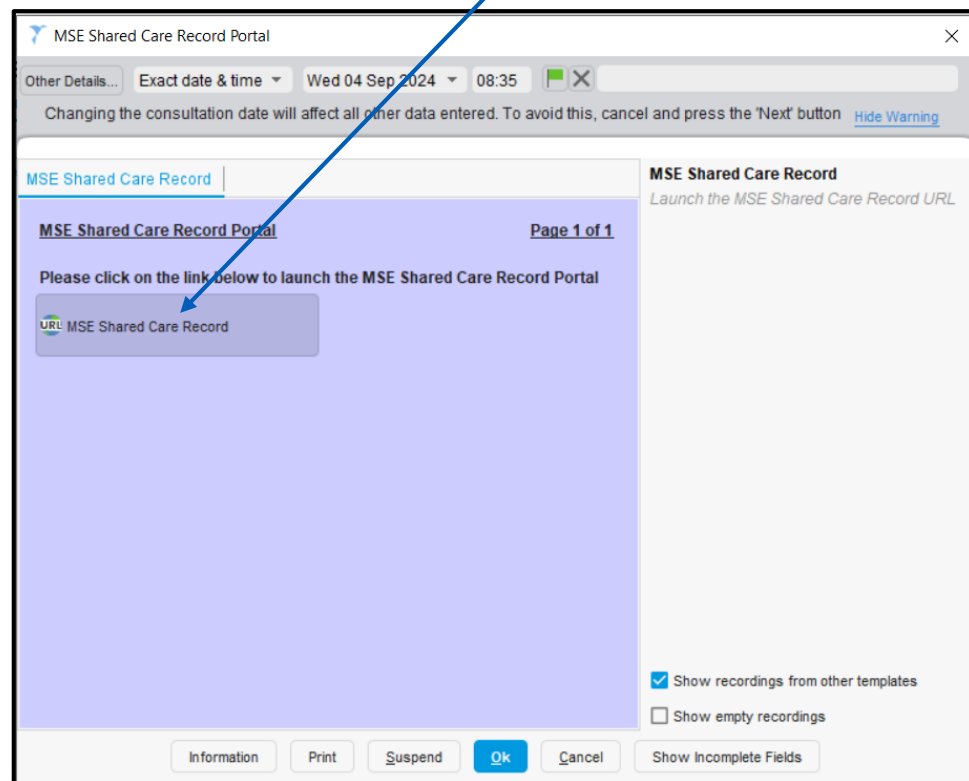

The MSE Shared Care Record function can only be accessed within the EPR, and will open in context for you to view data for that specific patient.

To access the MSE Shared Care Record, right click on the “MSE Shared Care Record Portal” Template and select the top option “MSE Shared Care Record Portal”.



The Shared Care Record Portal Template will open. Click on the button as shown, to open the URL.



The Shared Care Record will open in the Internet Browser.

You can expand the demographics information by clicking on it for example, clicking on the patient address will display the full address and contact details, as well as the GP information.

Some of the patient's clinical care services can be seen displayed in the tree on the left-hand side of the screen. Click on the chevron next to each one to expand the selection. The Community/ Mental Health node will display EPUT services (shown next slide).
